## EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2009- 10

RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING OVERTIME FOR EXEMPT AND NON-EXEMPT EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND TAXATION TO PROCESS INDIVIDUAL AND CORPORATE INCOME TAX RETURNS FOR TAX YEAR 2006 AND PRIOR

**WHEREAS,** the government of Guam sold the 2009 General Obligation Bond on June 3, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, \$112,000,000 of bond proceeds will pay 2006 and prior year individual and corporate tax refunds; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to issue the refund checks expeditiously to taxpayers, Department of Revenue and Taxation will need to authorize overtime for employees selected based on their comprehension of moderate to complicated tax returns, as well as knowledge and experience in the processing of tax returns.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, FELIX P. CAMACHO,** *I Maga' Lahen Guahan*, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested to me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do order:

- 1. Overtime. This Executive Order shall authorize overtime compensation effective June 6, 2009 and shall expire upon completion of the issuance of the bond proceeds for individual and corporate tax refunds for tax year 2006 and prior as determined by the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation.
- 2. Employees. The Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation shall authorize overtime compensation to designated employees of the Department of Revenue and Taxation employees who are responding to this Executive Order including the following exempt employees:
