## EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2009-11

## RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING OVERTTIME FOR EXEMPT AND NON-EXEMPT EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO PROCESS INDIVIDUAL AND CORPORATE TAX REFUNDS AND THE COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT AWARDED IN SUPERIOR COURT CASE NO. SP0206-93

WHEREAS, the government of Guam sold the General Obligation bond on June 3, 2009; and

WHEREAS, \$112,000,000 of bond proceeds will pay 2008 and prior year individual and corporate tax refunds and \$92,000 of bonds proceeds will pay the Cost of Living Adjustment awarded in Superior Court Case No. SP0206-93; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to expeditiously disburse refunds to taxpayers and COLA to the COLA Class, the Department of Administration will need to authorize overtime for employees selected to process and mail these checks.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, FELIX P. CAMACHO,** I Maga' Lahen Guahan, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested to me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do order:

1. Overtime. This Executive Order shall authorize overtime compensation effective June 19, 2009 and shall expire upon completion of the issuance of the bond proceeds for individual and corporate tax refunds for tax year 2008 and prior and the Cost of Living Adjustment as determined by the Director of the Department of Administration.

2. Employees. The Director of the Department of Administration shall authorize overtime compensation to the following exempt and non-exempt employees of the Department of Administration who are responding to this Executive Order:
