## **EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2014-14**

RELATIVE TO AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2014-04 TO AUTHORIZE THE GUAM REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY TO DEVELOP AN INVITATION FOR BID FOR IMPLEMENTING THE INTEGRATED MASS TRANSIT SYSTEM PILOT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Title 12, Guam Code Annotated Section 6102 charges the Guam Regional Transit Authority (GRTA), a public corporation of the Government of Guam, with "the exclusive franchise for the furnishing of public transportation within Guam and on its roads and highways"; and

WHEREAS, Title 12 Guam Code Annotated, Section 6105 authorizes GRTA to enter into contracts and to execute all instruments necessary or convenient in the exercise of its purpose and power; and

WHEREAS, GRTA and the Government of Guam are committed to improving accessibility to public transportation for all Guamanians; and

WHEREAS, the interests of efficiency and economy dictate that as the lead agency responsible for implementing the pilot program for integrated mass transit established by Executive Order 2014-04, GRTA should also take the lead in handling any procurements related to the pilot program.

**NOW, THEREFORE I, EDWARD J. B. CALVO**, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in by the Organic Act of Guam, do hereby ORDER:



- 1. Section 4 of E.O. 2014-04 is amended to read as follows:
  - 4. Upon development of a pilot program, GRTA shall be responsible for the implementation and operation of the pilot program developed and recommended by the Planning Team. GRTA shall use any method of source selection permitted by the Procurement Law of Guam and its Regulations that it deems to be in the best interest of the Territory.
