EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2014-20

RELATIVE TO DECLARING THE DAY
AFTER CHRISTMAS A HOLIDAY

WHEREAS, President Obama has declared the day after Christmas a federal holiday, which means federal agencies and offices, and banks will be closed; and

WHEREAS, this executive order aligns Guam with the federal government, recognizing the sense in closing the government of Guam on a day when it can transact no business with banks and federal agencies; and

WHEREAS, Title 1 Guam Code Annotated, Section 1000 (c) provides that: "In addition to the holidays specified in Subsection (a) of this Section, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan* may declare by Executive Order additional non-permanent holidays for special purposes."

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDDIE BAZA CALVO, I Maga'låhen Guåhan, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do hereby order that:

Friday, December 26, 2014, the day after Christmas, is declared as a Government of Guam holiday.
