EXECUTIVE ORDER NO: 85-7

TAGUAG MEMORIAL CEMETERY

WHEREAS, the Taguag Memorial Cemetery is the only public cemetery on Guam;
and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 66-20 established the rules and regulations for
the operation of the Taguag Memorial Cemetery under the Department of Public
Health and Welfare, now known as Department of Public Health and Social Serv-
ices; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 15-96 designated the Department of Parks and Recreation
the responsibility of administration, operations, and maintenance of all public
cemeteries; and

WHEREAS, the Taguag Memorial Cemetery is included in the Guam Territorial
Park System Inventory; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 66-20 states that a plot fee should be charged and
that payment should be made to the Office of Vital Statistics;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICARDO J. BORDALLO, Governor of Guam, by the powers
vested in me by the Organic Act, as amended, do hereby order:

1. Executive Order 66-20 shall be applicable to the Department of Parks
and Recreation and so therefore, the Department of Public Health and
Welfare should read Department of Parks and Recreation and the Office
of Vital Statistics should read Parks Division; and
2. that fees are to be collected and expended for the cost of opening and
closing of graves as well as general maintenance of the grounds and
deposited into a Taguag Memorial Cemetery Revolving Fund; and
3. that the funds shall be deposited in a local bank; and
4. that the deposits in this fund be comprised exclusively of private fees
and no Government Funds; and

6. that the Parks and Recreation Commission is required to submit an annual financial statement of the Taguag Memorial Cemetery Revolving Fund to the Office of the Governor and other agencies as appropriate.
