EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 86-18

ESTABLISHMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS & RECREATION YOUTH
ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON GRAFITTI, VANDALISM AND LITTERING

WHEREAS, Guam is blessed with beautiful beaches, significant historic features, important cultural resources, natural features, scenic landscapes, and a variety of recreation facilities, all important to our heritage; and

WHEREAS, a major problem facing Guam today is the destruction, injury, disfigurement, and defacement of our island's heritage resources; and

WHEREAS, the youth of Guam are concerned about the preservation of their heritage; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation is committed to improving the maintenance of our parks and preventing vandalism;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICARDO J. BORDALLO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, I do hereby order as follows:

1. The establishment of the Youth Advisory Committee on Vandalism, Grafitti and Littering within the Executive Branch of the Government of Guam,
2. The Committee shall advise the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation on new and innovative ways to prevent vandalism, grafitti and other problems detrimental to our island and its beauty.
3. The Committee shall be composed of youth members from each of our island's villages and shall be appointed by the Governor.
4. In conjunction with the creation of this Committee, the Director of Parks and Recreation shall implement an outreach program to prevent vandalism, grafitti and littering in the villages of Guam and shall submit a recommendation to the Governor within 90 days of the first meeting of the Committee.
