EXECUTIVE ORDER 92-24

Declaring a Civil Defense, Public Health and Safety Emergency and Authorizing the Emergency Procurement of Generators and Other Materials and Services Needed for Recovery from the Damage caused by Typhoon Omar.

WHEREAS, on August 28, 1992 Typhoon Omar passed over the island of Guam causing widespread damage; and


WHEREAS, various departments have been authorized to expend funds to recovery from Typhoon Omar;

WHEREAS, the Procurement Law permits emergency procurement of Supplies and Services when there is declaration of a Territorial State of Emergency following a natural disaster;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH F. ADA, Governor, by the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam and the laws of Guam order that:


The Directors of the Departments of Administration and Public Works and other Directors with procurement authority are authorized to use emergency procurement procedures in accordance with the Procurement Law and Regulations to procure generators and other materials and services needed for recovery from the damage caused by Typhoon Omar.
