EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 92-25

AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 91-24


RELATIVE TO CREATING A COMMITTEE ON THE AMERICANS WITH  
DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM

- WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 91-24 established a Committee on the Americans with Disabilities Act; and
- WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Vocational Rehabilitation was appointed the Chairperson of the Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the Commission on Persons with Disabilities is concerned with all issues affecting persons with disabilities while the Department of Vocational Rehabilitation's concern is primarily focused on employment; and
- WHEREAS, P.L. 20-213 mandates that the Commission serve as the central clearing house for public and private activities which address the needs of persons with disabilities in Guam; and
- WHEREAS, it is the Committee's interest to amend Executive Order No. 91-24 to comply with this mandate.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH F. ADA, Governor of the Territory of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do hereby order:

1. Section 2 of Executive Order No. 91-24 is amended to read as follows: The Executive Director of the Commission on Persons with Disabilities shall serve as the Chairperson for the Committee on the Americans with Disabilities Act.
2. Section 3 of Executive Order No. 91-24 is amended to include a representative from the Department of Vocational Rehabilitation within the Executive Committee on the Americans with Disabilities Act.
