EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 94-08

RETURNING TO THE GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM
OPERATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
CERTAIN PROCUREMENT AND RELATED ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS, procurement irregularities were discovered at the Guam Public School System operated by the Department of Education and in order to restore integrity to the procurement process Executive Order No. 93-11 was issued which transferred certain procurement authority to the General Services Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Public School System operated by the Department of Education has adopted procurement regulations in accord with the procurement law [5 GCA Chapter 5,] as amended; and

WHEREAS, personnel at the Guam Public School System operated by the Department of Education have been trained in procurement according to the new regulations and 5 GCA Chapter 5, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works is involved in procuring several vital construction projects for the Guam Public School System operated by the Department of Education and it would be imprudent to change the procurement authority for construction at this time,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH F. ADA, Governor of the Territory of Guam, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, hereby order that effective immediately:


1. all procurement and related activity including but not limited to purchasing supplies (including books) and services, and receiving and controlling inventory be transferred back to the Guam Public School System operated by the Department of Education from the Department of Administration's General Services Agency; and
2. all procurement and related activity for construction by the Guam School System operated by the Department of Education continue at the Department of Public Works.
