EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 95-04

"REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE MEANS TEST PER  
PUBLIC LAW 22-161 OF THE FIVE (5) ILLNESSES  
SUCH AS TUBERCULOSIS, LYTICO, BODIG, INSULIN FOR DIABETES,  
AND IRREVERSIBLE RENAL FAILURE OF THE  
MEDICALLY INDIGENT PROGRAM"

- WHEREAS, Public Law 22-161, Section 3(c) authorized the Department of Public Health and Social Services to adopt rules and regulations to establish eligibility criteria separate and apart from the existing Medically Indigent Program (MIP) poverty guidelines, to specifically address the health care needs of individuals afflicted with the five medical conditions as stated; and
- WHEREAS, Public Law 22-161 mandates that the rules are to be adopted pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Law but the procedures for adoption of final regulations will take several months; and
- WHEREAS, the people who are under the previous Free Care Illness Program are in immediate need of medical services; and
- WHEREAS, in order to maintain federal funding for the treatment of eligible persons afflicted with the five Illnesses and maximize participation in federally-funded health care programs; and
- WHEREAS, the following "Income and Resource Limitations" shall be adopted as a Means Test for individuals afflicted with the five illnesses applying for medical coverage under MIP; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CARL T.C. GUTIERREZ, Governor of the Territory of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do hereby order that:





1. The DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF THE INDIVIDUALS AFFLICTED WITH THE FIVE MEDICAL CONDITIONS OF THE MIP, herein above stated, are adopted and promulgated effective immediately as emergency regulations which shall remain in effect until final rules and regulations are adopted pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Law or 90 days, whichever first occurs; and

2. The Department of Public Health and Social Services shall proceed to public hearing of the proposed regulations as soon as possible.
