EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 82-25

WHEREAS, Section 26 of P.L. 15-147 provided for a salary increase to some department heads and agencies of the Government of Guam to be made effective January, 1981,

WHEREAS, the salary increase under P.L. 15-147 did not include department heads for the Agency for Human Resources and Development (AHRD), Criminal Justice Planning Agency (CJPA), Guam Health Planning and Development Agency (GHPDA), and Mental Health and Substance Abuse Agency (MHSAA); and

WHEREAS, AHRD, GHPDA, CJPA, and MHSAA were created by the Governor's authority under the Organic Act of Guam and are considered to be departments and agencies of the Government of Guam; and

WHEREAS, the heads of these departments and agencies are assuming comparable responsibilities and authority to that of the other heads of the departments and agencies that were granted salary increases under P.L. 15-147; and

WHEREAS, in order to create compensation parity among department heads within the Government of Guam;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PAUL M. CALVO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, do hereby order as follows:

NOTWITHSTANDING any provisions of any previous Executive Orders to the contrary,

1. The salary for the Directors and Deputy Directors for the following agencies is as follows:

Director, Agency for Human Resources and Development (AHRD)	(\$34,000)
Deputy Director, AHRD	(\$30,000)
Administrator, Guam Health Planning and Development Agency (GHPDA)	(\$34,000)
Deputy Director, GHPDA	(\$30,000)

Criminal Justice Planning

Agency (CJPA) (\$34,000)

Deputy Director, CJPA (\$30,000)

Administrator, Mental Health and

Substance Abuse Agency (MHSAA) (\$34,000)

Associate Administrator, MHSAA (\$30,000)

2. The salary adjustments for the above positions within
aforementioned departments shall be made effective January,
1981.


3. This Order shall be effective immediately.
