Executive Order No. 6 - 49

TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM

Subject: Transfer Tax on Transfers of Motor Vehicles.


WHEREAS, Civil Regulations with the Force and Effect of Law in Guam, Chapter 29, provides for tax on motor vehicles sold by other than a licensed dealer based on the sale price of the vehicle, substantiated by affidavit of the vendor,

WHEREAS, considerable revenues owing to the Government are being lost due to collaboration by numerous vendors and vendees in submitting obviously false sale prices and affidavits,

WHEREAS, the law should be revised to protect the revenues of the Government in the interest of the people and time is of the essence in preventing further losses,

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of Guam I decree that the attached proposed act relating to transfer tax on transfers of motor vehicles shall become law September 20, 1949 as Public Law 11.
