
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2-54

WHEREAS, Public Law 77, First Guam Legislature, 1952 (Second) Regular Session was passed by the Legislature on July 2, 1952, and approved by the Governor of Guam on July 29, 1952; and


WHEREAS, to make said Public Law 77 effective, the Secretary of Guam must perform certain acts and keep certain records;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of authority vested in me by Sections 6 and 7 of the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, I hereby assign the Secretary of Guam to perform any and all acts and to keep all records necessary to carry out the provisions of Public Law 77, First Guam Legislature, 1952, (Second) Regular Session.
