EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 62-10

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 62-9 issued as a result of the destruction inflicted by Typhoon Karen, set a curfew of 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, recovery operations have reached such a point that some relaxation of the measures imposed may be had at this time;


NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the foregoing and pursuant to the authority vested in me as Acting Governor of Guam by the Organic Act of Guam and the Guam Civil Defense Act, it is hereby ordered that Executive Order 62-9 is hereby amended effective immediately to read as follows:

1. Effective immediately no person shall be permitted in or upon the public streets, highways, or any other public place, grounds, or buildings between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m., without a permit therefor from the Director of Public Safety.
2. Such permit shall be granted only to those persons who can establish legitimate need to be abroad during the prohibited hours by reason of their employment or business.
3. This order shall remain in effect until revoked by Executive Order
