EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 63-10

GUAM TOURIST COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Department of Commerce of the Government of Guam has now been constituted with a tourist section therein for the purpose of encouraging the establishment of a tourist industry on our island; and

WHEREAS, it would be most desirable to insure local participation in this project with liaison with the various groups interested in and affected by this activity; and


WHEREAS, it would greatly increase the efficiency and effectiveness of the newly created tourist section to have an advisory commission to assist in its efforts;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Manuel F. L. Guerrero, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, do hereby establish the Guam Tourist Commission to be composed of seven members, one of whom I shall designate Chairman. The Speaker of the Legislature shall appoint two members, the President of the Chamber of Commerce shall appoint two members and I shall appoint three members. Members will serve for two years each. The Committee shall be constituted for the aims and purposes aforesaid and shall meet at the call of the Chairman.
