EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 64- 7

MEMORIAL DAY HOLIDAY


Pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 6(b), of the Organic Act of Guam, and Rule 11.32 of the Personnel Rules and Regulations of the Government of Guam, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. Friday, May 29, 1964, shall be a holiday for employees of the Government of Guam. All activities of the Government shall be closed for business on that day except those where the public convenience and necessity require continued service.
2. An employee whose regular work week includes Friday, May 29, 1964, and who is excused from duty on that day, shall receive only his basic rate of compensation.
3. Those employees who are required to work shall be compensated therefor in accord with Rule 11.31, Personnel Rules and Regulations. Overtime work performed shall be compensated at the same rate as for overtime work performed on other days. Holiday pay shall not be included in the rate of basic compensation for purposes of computing overtime compensation.
4. An employee whose regular work week does not include Friday, May 29, 1964, may be excused from duty on a subsequent work day.
