
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 67-4

REDEFINITION OF ORGANIZED VILLAGES  
UNDER THE BUILDING LAW OF GUAM


Pursuant to the provisions of Section 31002, Government Code of Guam, I hereby redefine and designate the location and boundaries of organized villages having public utilities within the territory as those being shown on Land Management Drawing No. G1-53T9, dated July 23, 1953, as incorporated in Executive Order No. 2-53, and Land Management Drawing No. F3-67S32, dated March 28, 1967, showing the organized boundary of Tumon, and Land Management Drawing No. F3-67S33, dated March 28, 1967, showing the organized boundary of Dededo, and Land Management Drawing No. F3-67S31, dated March 28, 1967, showing the organized boundary of Tamuning. All such drawings are specifically incorporated herein. As provided in Section 31002, Government Code of Guam, all structures designed as single family dwellings, located within the villages affected, shall comply with all provisions of the Building Code of Guam.

This executive order shall be effective this date.
