## EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 67-5 <u>AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 64-4</u> <u>GUAM BOXING REGULATIONS</u>

Section 24 of Executive Order No. 64-4, entitled "Rules and Regulations Relative to Boxing in Guam," is hereby amended to read as follows:

> "24. Every person, club, corporation or association, which shall hold any boxing exhibition or performance under a license obtained from said Commission shall, within seventy-two hours after the termination of every contest, furnish to the Commission a written report on forms furnished by the Commission, duly verified by the Secretary or other officer, showing the exact amount of tickets sold for such contest and the amount of the gross proceeds thereof and such other matters as the Commission may prescribe."
