EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 68-23

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS


WHEREAS, Public Law 9-208 established the Department of Corrections within the Government of Guam; and

WHEREAS, the Act was effective July 18, 1968, however, Section 55013 of the Act authorizes a delay of up to six months for the actual inter-departmental transfer of functions so as to provide an orderly change of responsibility;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Public Law 9-208, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. The Juvenile Detention Home shall be transferred from the Department of Public Health and Social Services to the Department of Corrections effective October 1, 1968. All personnel, records and facilities involved shall be transferred that date.
2. The Guam Penitentiary shall be transferred from the Department of Public Safety to the Department of Corrections effective November 1, 1968. All personnel, records and facilities involved shall be transferred that date.
3. The Department of Labor and Personnel shall proceed to take the necessary action to effectuate the above as to the officers and employees concerned. The Department of Finance shall make the necessary financial allocations as provided for by Section 4 of Public Law 9-208.
