EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 69-8

COMMISSION ON EXECUTIVE CLEMENCY

WHEREAS, the power of executive clemency vested in the Governor of Guam is one of the most sensitive and difficult functions of the office to exercise; and


WHEREAS, it would be helpful and desirable to form a commission to study past criminal convictions and to make recommendations to the Governor in appropriate instances;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Manuel F. L. Guerrero, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, do hereby order as follows:


1. There is hereby established the Commission on Executive Clemency to be composed of the Attorney General, Chairman; the Chief Commissioner of Guam, the Director of Public Safety or his representative, the Director of Corrections or his representative and the Director of Public Health and Social Services or his representative.

2. The Commission shall meet at the call of the Chairman and shall review and study all criminal convictions occurring 15 years or more in the past. The Commission shall consider the nature of the offense, the circumstances surrounding the event and the conduct of the offender both before and after the conviction in question. The Commission shall report to the Governor from time to time as the review continues and shall make appropriate recommendations for executive action.
