EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 71-10

HOLIDAY REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, Section 4004, Government Code of Guam, requires that the Governor promulgate personnel rules and regulations by Executive Order subject to the criteria established by Title V, Chapter I, Government Code of Guam; and

WHEREAS, there are inconsistencies in the applicability of existing holiday regulations; and

WHEREAS, the inconsistencies have resulted in the indiscriminate treatment of employees with regards to holiday benefits; and


WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission has approved a revised holiday policy for Government of Guam employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CARLOS G. CA ACHO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, do hereby approve and promulgate the attached holiday regulation as the standard policy for employees of the Government of Guam.


All prior rules, regulations, policies, memoranda, or Executive Order in conflict with this order are hereby superseded.
