AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 71-9

## IMPLEMENTATION OF P.L. 10-194 - THE UNIFORM CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES ACT

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health and Social Services does not yet possess the capacity to effectively administer P. L. 10-194; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health and Social Services has not yet issued the rules and regulations necessary for the implementation of P.L. 10-194 and as required by paragraph 19 of Executive Order 71-9;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kurt S. Moylan, Acting Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 6 of the Organic Act of Guam do hereby amend Executive Order 71-9 as follows:

- (1) Paragraph (15); where the word "three" appears this shall mean and read "six".
- (2) Paragraph (16); where the word "three" appears this shall mean and read "six".
- (3) Paragraph (19); where the words and numerals "forty-five (45) days" appear this shall mean and read "eighteen (18) weeks".
