AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 71-3:
SOCIAL SERVICES ADVISORY COMMITTEE


WHEREAS, the present membership of the Social Services Advisory Committee is limited in number; and

WHEREAS, an increase in membership would provide a more representative and comprehensive community viewpoint.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Carlos G. Camacho, Governor of Guam, do hereby amend paragraph number two of the Executive Order to read as follows:

2. That the membership of the Social Services Advisory Committee shall be composed of thirteen persons, four of whom shall represent the recipients of the programs advised by the Committee, four of whom shall represent Government agencies or elected local or Territorial officials, and five of whom shall represent private social service agencies, churches, business, or the community at large. Each member shall serve for four years. The members chosen from among the recipients of the programs shall be chosen with the approval of the recipients of the various programs to be advised by the Committee. All other members shall be selected by the Governor.

DESIGNATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES AS A TERRITORY
SOLE AGENCY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PREVENTION
AND TREATMENT OF ALCOHOLISM

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism Prevention, Treatment, and Rehabilitation Act of 1970, Public Law 91-616, authorizes federal support for comprehensive programs for the prevention and treatment of alcohol abuse and alcoholism; and

WHEREAS, this Act requires that a single agency of each state and territory be responsible for the implementation and provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Department of Public Health and Social Services offers more and better facilities for the implementation of such program than does the Guam Memorial Hospital; and

WHEREAS, a satisfactory agreement has been reached between Guam Memorial Hospital and the Department of Public Health and Social Services for the transfer of such program;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Sections 6(b) and 9(c) of the Organic Act of Guam, the following are put into effect by this Executive Order:

1. Executive Order No. 70-27 is hereby repealed;
2. The Department of Public Health and Social Services is hereby designated as the sole agency of the territory responsible for the prevention, treatment and rehabilitation of alcoholism for purposes of compliance with the above cited federal law;
3. All personnel, equipment, supplies and material used in the program heretofore attached to the Guam Memorial Hospital are hereby transferred to the Department of Public Health and Social Services, with the actual mechanics of transfer being worked out between the administrator of the hospital and the Director of Public Health and Social Services and the Department of Administration.

4. The Bureau of Planning, Budgeting and Management is hereby directed to transfer from the hospital to the Department of Public Health and Social Services the amounts to be allocated to the above program for fiscal year 1973. Any further budget request shall be the responsibility of the Director of Public Health and Social Services.
