EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 73-25

PUBLIC EMPLOYEES MINIMUM WAGE

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 70-29 authorized the recruitment of employees in positions at Pay Ranges 3, 4 and 5 above the minimum step in accordance with the provision of Section 2 of Public Law 10-172, approved on August 6, 1970, which provided that the minimum wage for government employees shall be no less than Two Dollars (\$2.00) per hour; and


WHEREAS, the pay adjustments brought about by Public Laws 11-94, 10-172 and 11-199 have increased the pay range schedule established by Section 4103 of the Government Code of Guam to the point that the recruitment of employees at Pay Range 3, 4 and 5 above the minimum and all other employees whose hourly rate will be less than the minimum wage are not warranted;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, it is hereby ordered that Executive Order 72-24 is repealed. This act is retroactive to July 1, 1973.
