AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 74-3 CHANGING THE TER LICENSE TO PERMIT.

WHEREAS, the term "licensee" and "license" have been misunderstood and since other licenses may be required to be obtained from other departments of government by persons covered by Executive Order No. 74-3;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Carlos G. Camacho, Governor of Guam do hereby amend Executive Order No. 74-3 by substituting the term "Health Permit" wherever the term "license" appears in said Executive Order and attached regulations and by substituting the term "permit holder" wherever the term "licensee" appears in said Executive Order and attached Regulations.
