EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 74-7

GUAM DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME - RESCINDED

WHEREAS, Section 223, Government Code of Guam, established a standard time for Guam, known as Guam Standard Time; and

WHEREAS, such section further provides that the Governor may provide by Executive Order that Guam Standard Time shall be advanced not more than one (1) hour; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 73-28 was adopted to aid in conserving fuel during the energy crisis; and

WHEREAS, this method of conserving fuel has been found to result in relatively insignificant savings to merit continuation of the daylight saving time; and

WHEREAS, many parents of school children have expressed concern about safety of their children in the dark hours of the morning;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Carlos G. Camacho, Governor of Guam, do hereby order Executive Order No. 73-28 rescinded and direct that at 2 o'clock ante meridian on February 24, 1974, the time shall be retarded one (1) hour to the standard time of the 150th Meridian of longitude east from Greenwich.
