EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 76-13

DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME

WHERMAS, Section 223(b) of the Government Code of Guam states that:

"(b) The Governor may provide by Executive Order that at two (2) o'clock ante meridian of a day fixed therein standard time..., shall be advanced not more than one (1) hour from the time... When the time is advanced pursuant to this subsection, it shall be known as Guam Daylight Savings Time."; and

WHEREAS, the public streets and highways are presently littered with telephone poles and other debris, making driving said highways, in the dark, hazardous and a threat to the safety of the community; and

WHEREAS, an extra hour of sunlight can be better used by the people to continue in their efforts to recover from the havor caused by Super Typhoon Pamela;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICARDO J. BORDALLO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, and the aforestated section of the Government Code of Guam, do hereby order that as of two (2) o'clock ante meridian on Wednesday, May 26, 1976, the time shall be advanced one hour and that said ordered Guam Daylight Savings Time shall continue until revoked by Executive Order of the Governor.
