REPEAL OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 76-12

WHEREAS, thirty (30) days have elapsed since the execution of Executive Order No. 76-12, declaring that a State of Emergency exists on Guam; and

WHEREAS, more than sixty percent (60%) of the Island's electricity has been restored; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety is now able to deploy its personnel to their regular duties; and

WHEREAS, the conditions that existed on May 22, 1976, which prompted the declaration of a state of emergency, no longer exists:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICARDO J. BORDALLO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do hereby order the repeal of Executive Order No. 76-12 in its entirety.
