EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 78-31

AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 77-11

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration (LEAA) has informed the government of Guam that the Territorial Crime Commission Supervisory Board must include certain categories of citizens; and

WHEREAS, complying with this advise would require either removing members or adding additional members; and

WHEREAS, the current Board has satisfactorily fulfilled its responsibilities making it unnecessary and improper to remove any; and

WHEREAS, adding four additional members would resolve the problem;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICARDO J. BORDALLO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do hereby order that Executive Order 77-11 be amended to read as follows:

"2. The Commission shall be governed by a Supervisory Board which shall be composed of the following eleven (11) fifteen (15) members appointed by the Governor, who shall serve terms of five (5) years unless the member is a public official who was originally appointed by virtue of his position, in which case he shall serve as long as he remains in his position: the Attorney General, the Director of Public Safety, the Director of Corrections, one (1) Municipal Commissioner, the Chairman of the Legislature's Committee on Public Safety, Military and Veterans Affairs, a Judge of the Superior Court knowledgeable in the area of juvenile justice, one (1) judicial administrative officer, and four (4) eight (8) representatives of the general public, one of which shall be a youth between the age of 16 and 22 26 years old."

This shall become effective immediately.
