EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 79-25

TRAINING ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Department of Administration has been designated as the administering agency under the provisions of the Intergovernmental Personnel Act (IPA); and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Personnel Act as a condition for the granting and receipt of federal assistance requires the establishment of a Training Advisory Council to assist the Director of Administration in assuring the intergovernmental coordination of various training programs; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 72-11 was promulgated on April 17, 1972, establishing the Training Advisory Council for purpose explained in the aforementioned; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 72-11 was amended by Executive Order 75-42 to delete the paragraph relative to the composition of the Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PAUL M. CALVO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, do hereby order that Executive Order 75-42 be rescinded to amend the paragraph relative to the composition of the Council immediately following the promulgation clause and substituting therefor the following:

"The Training Advisory Council is hereby established to consist of eight (8) members as follows:

- (a) Director, Department of Administration;
- (b) Executive Director, Civil Service Commission;
- (c) Director, Department of Public Works;
- (d) Director, Department of Revenue and Taxation;
- (e) Director, Department of Public Safety;
- (f) Director, Department of Labor;
- (g) President, University of Guam; and
- (h) Provost, Guam Community College

The Director of Administration shall serve as Chairman of the Council. In the absence of the Chairman, the Vice Chairman, who shall be elected by the Council members, shall serve in the Chairman's capacity."


Any other Executive Orders in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they so conflict.
