EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 80-10

SALARY SURVEY AND CLASSIFICATION STUDY IMPLEMENTATION POLICY AND PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 78-41 relative to the implementation of the Government of Guam Salary Survey and Classification Task Force was promulgated on December 12, 1978; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 79-14 effected a moratorium on the implementation of the classification and pay recommendations of the Salary Survey and Classification Task Force because of extreme financial constraints of the Government of Guam; and

WHEREAS, further delay on the implementation of the study would have severe adverse effects on the morale of deserving employees; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 1980, I submitted a bill to the Guam Legislature requesting appropriation, among other things, to implement the Salary Survey and Classification Study; and

WHEREAS, on August 4, 1980, the Guam Legislature duly passed Bill No. 955 to implement the recommendations of the Salary Survey and Classification Study; and

WHEREAS, on August 22, , 1980, I signed Bill No. 955 which now becomes Public Law No. 15-136 ;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PAUL M. CALVO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do hereby approve and promulgate, as attached hereto, the policy and procedures for the implementation of the Salary Survey and Classification Study.

CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION GOVERNMENT OF GUAM

SALARY SURVEY AND CLASSIFICATION STUDY IMPLEMENTATION POLICY AND PROCEDURES:

The following policy and procedures are set forth in the implementation of the Salary Survey and Classification Task Force recommendations, subject to the provisions established by law.

All existing pay policies and procedures relating to position reclassification and pay range reassignments are deemed inappropriate and shall not be applicable in the implementation of the new classification and pay plans.

I. Reclassification of Positions:

The reclassification of positions shall be in accordance with each department/agency reallocation list prepared by the Commission in coordination with respective personnel offices. The Commission shall provide each department/agency with the official copy for the processing of personnel actions.

II. Method of Implementation:

A "Save Pay Policy" is provided by P.L. No. 15-136 so that any employee whose position has been designated for demotion as a result of the Salary Survey and Classification Study shall continue to serve in such position title without loss of pay or change of position title until such employee vacates his position.

A. Graded (white collar) Job Classification

The method of implementation authorized by P.L. <u>15-136</u> for positions in the Graded Pay Range Schedule is for a step-to-step pay adjustment.

1. Effect of the new plan on positions that are being upgraded.

All employees occupying positions that are being reclassified to a class with a higher maximum salary rate (step 10) than their position's present pay range shall retain their present step in the new pay range.

2. Effect of the new plan on positions that are being downgraded.

All employees occupying positions that are being reclassified to a class with a lower maximum salary rate (step 10) than their position's present pay range shall retain their present position titles and salary rates until such time those employees vacate their present position.

3. Effect of the new plan on positions that are remaining status quo, range-wise.

All employees occupying positions that are being reclassified to a class with the same pay range as their present pay range shall retain their present rate and step upon reclassification.

B. <u>Ungraded (blue collar)</u> Job Classifications

The method of implementation authorized by P.L. <u>15-136</u> for positions in the Wage Schedule is for a two-step pay adjustment.

1. Effect of the new plan on positions that are being upgraded.

All employees occupying positions that are being reclassified to a class with a higher maximum salary rate (step 5) of the Wage Schedule than their position's present pay range shall receive a pay adjustment equivalent to a two-step pay increase from their present salary rate, but not less than the minimum rate established for the wage level and not to exceed the maximum salary rate (step 5) of the recommended wage pay level upon reclassification.

2. Effect of the new plan on positions that are being downgraded.

All employees occupying positions that are being reclassified to a class with a lower maximum salary rate (step 5) of the Wage Schedule than their position's present title and salary rates until such time those employees vacates their present position.

III. Minimum Qualification Requirements:

The new and/or revised minimum qualification requirements for all classes of positions shall not apply to the employee now occupying "classified" positions, but shall be applied for all initial recruitment, and subsequent promotion, transfer, reclassification and other personnel actions upon implementation of the Classification and Pay Plan.

IV. Employee's Anniversary Dates:

Implementation of the reclassification actions shall not change the employee's anniversary dates.

V. <u>Implementation Date</u>:

Effective date shall be no earlier than July 1, 1980.

VI. Pay Differentials:

Adjustments for pay differentials such as overtime, night differential, environmental pay, detail/acting pay will not be affected in line with the Salary Survey and Classification Study implementation unless otherwise directed by the Governor.

VII. Reclassification Review:

Employee requests for classification review shall be in accordance with the respective personnel agency's personnel rules and regulations.

VIII. Modification of the Occupational Listing of Classes:

The attached modification to the Occupational Listing of classes are hereby made in order to incorporate significant reorganizational changes and/or development of new programs implemented subsequent to September 1978 which affected the Classification Plan.
