EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 84-9

ENERGY CONSERVATION IN EXISTING BUILDINGS

WHEREAS, the Guam State Energy Conservation Plan was established in 1977-78 under P.L. 94-163, as amended by P.L. 94-385 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the State Energy Conservation Plan incorporated mandated program measures concerning Thermal Efficiency Standards in existing buildings; and

WHEREAS, said standards contribute to energy conservation in all buildings in the Territory; and

WHEREAS, new regulations have been promulgated by the U.S. Department of Energy (10 CFR PART 420.6, August 30, 1983) that require each state to revise their State Energy Conservation Plan to include all EXISTING BUILDINGS in the appropriate building code in effect; and

WHEREAS, Guam currently follows the Uniform Building Code, Chapter 53 as amended with regard to energy conservation in buildings;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICARDO J. BORDALLO, Governor of Guam, by virtue of authority vested in me by the Organic


Act, as amended, do hereby order as follows:

1. That all existing buildings shall meet the requirements of the Uniform Building Code, Chapter 53 as amended with regard to lighting efficiency standards.

2. That the Department of Public Works take steps to assure that all plans for modification, reconstruction and rehabilitation of existing buildings, meet the lighting efficiency standards requirements as set forth in the Federal Register, Volume 48, No. 169, August 30, 1983, P. 39360 of Uniform Building Code, Chapter 53 as amended.


This Order shall take effect immediately.
