

NAVAL GOVERNMENT OF GUAM

Executive Order Number 2-47

TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM

Subsection 2 of Section G of Chapter XXIX of The Civil Regulations With The Force and Effect Of Law In Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:


"Application for the registration and license of vehicles shall be made annually by the owner thereof to the Head of the Department of Records and Accounts on prescribed official blanks through the Chief of Police. The application shall contain, in addition to such other particulars as may be required by the Head of the Department of Records and Accounts, a statement of the name, place of residence of the applicant and a brief description of the vehicle. The description shall include the name of the maker, horse-power and motor and serial numbers. All applications for licenses for motor vehicles shall be sworn to by the applicant before the Head of the Department of Records and Accounts or a Notary Public.

"Registration plates issued pursuant to this sub-section shall be issued for a registration year commencing on the first day of April of one year and expiring on the 31st day of March of the year following. Registration plates for the succeeding year, at the option of the owner, may be used on and after the 15th day of March of the current year."
