Executive Order No. 2 - 49.

TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM

Subject: Schedule of Customs Warehouse Service Charges.

WHEREAS, the Naval Government of Guam performs handling services in connection with the importation of commercial cargo into Guam, and

WHEREAS, this service normally is supplied by private enterprise and paid for by the importer,

NOW THEREFORE, the following regulations shall govern importation of commercial cargo into Guam:

"Cargo shipments imported into Guam and arriving by sea for the account of commercial firms, which are processed at the dock by the Navy and then transported on Navy trucks to the customs house where the shipment is checked, received, sorted and stored, or verified and delivered to the importers' warehouse adjacent to Camp Piti shall be subject to handling charges to be collected by the Customs and Immigration Department as follows:

- (1) No charge will be assessed upon shipments valued at \$5.00 or less.
- (2) Household effects consigned to individuals intended for their household use, are subject to charges herein specified.
- (3) All handling charges for commercial cargo shall be computed on a measurement ton of 40 cubic feet or a weight ton of 2,000 pounds, whichever will produce the greater revenue.
- (4) The following charges will be made where the measurement ton basis is applicable on packages or pieces not exceeding 4,000 pounds gross weight or not over 40 lineal feet:

(6) SURTAXES ON HEAVY LIFTS

All packages or pieces weighing over 4,000 pounds shall, in addition to the rates provided in paragraph (4) above, be assessed a surtax at rates listed below on a basis of 2,000 pounds.

SURTAXES ON LONG LENGTHS

All packages or pieces over 40 feet in length shall in addition to the rates provided in paragraph (5) above, be assessed per ton of 2,000 pounds, or 40 cubic feet, whichever creates the greater revenue, a surtax at the rates below:

- (8) Where the importer takes delivery of his merchandise at the pier, the charges listed in paragraph (4) will be reduced by \$1.25 per revenue ton.
- (9) Naval Military Government letter A9/A3-1,RDW, dated 12 April 1946, approved by Deputy Chief Military Government Officer, 19 April 1946, is hereby rescinded."
