EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 17-59

FEDERAL AID PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the various Federal Aid Programs made applicable to Guam by Acts of Congress provide for the preparation of territorial plans, rules and regulations, the making of contracts, and other implementation in documentary form; and

WHEREAS, correspondence is required from time to time with different departments, agencies, and officers of the United States Government in connection with such programs; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that such programs be coordinated and not conflict with general policies of the Government of Guam pursuant to law;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Sections 6(a) and 6(b) of the Organic Act of Guam, it is hereby directed as follows:

1. All territorial plans, rules and regulations prepared under any Federal Aid Program, including any amendments, revisions or repeals thereof, and all contracts, are to be subject to final approval by the Governor. No such plans or rules and regulations, including any amendments, revisions or repeals thereof, or any such contracts, are to be submitted to any Federal Officer, department or agency, either in preliminary or final form, or for either tentative or final approval, except upon prior approval by the Governor.


2. All correspondence connected with any Federal Aid Program is to be prepared for the signature of the Governor, except as otherwise specifically authorized.

3. Federal Aid Programs include those programs administered pursuant to the following laws, as now in effect or hereafter amended:



and any other program of Federal aid now applicable, or hereafter made applicable, to Guam.
