EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 4-60

TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS OF TREASURER OF GUAM

Pursuant to the authority vested in me by Sections 6(b) and 9(c) of the Organic Act of Guam, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. All functions of the Treasurer of Guam, as prescribed by law or executive order, are hereby transferred to the Director of Finance.

2. Subsection 2a of Executive Order No. 5-59 is amended to read:

"a. Office of the Director. The Office of the Director shall be the supervising and policy-making office for the Department of Finance. The Director of Finance shall be the head of the Department of Finance and the Chief Official of the Office of the Director. The Director shall be charged with the overall administration of the Department of Finance and shall have general supervision of all the personnel and operations of the Department. Unless otherwise provided by law, or by the Governor, from time to time, he shall have general cognizance of all financial affairs of the Government of Guam. He shall be responsible for the receipt, deposit in authorized depositories, and disbursement of all public funds. Ex officio, he is the Director of Welfare, the Insurance Commissioner of Guam and the Uniform Securities Act Administrator."

3. Subsection 2e of Executive Order No. 5-59 is hereby rescinded.

4. The official title of the Director of Finance with respect to functions transferred to him by this order shall be: "Director of Finance".

5. The Office of Treasurer of Guam is hereby abolished.

6. The Director of Finance is authorized to designate such employees of the Department of Finance as his deputies or assistants as may be necessary to carry out the functions transferred by this order.

7. This order shall take effect May 2, 1960.
