EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.  $63 - \frac{13}{3}$ 

TRANSFER OF OFFICE OF CIVIL DEFENSE FROM DEPARIMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF COMMISSIONER

Pursuant to the authority vested in me by Sections 6(b) and 9(c) of the Organic Act of Guam, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. Executive Order No. 61-3, dated January 9, 1961, transferring and consolidating the Office of Civil Defense with the Department of Public Safety, is hereby rescinded.

2. The Office of Civil Defense is hereby transferred to and consolidated with the Office of the Chief Commissioner.

3. The Office of Civil Defense is hereby designated as a division within the Office of the Chief Commissioner, the head of which shall be the Deputy Director of Civil Defense who shall perform his duties under the immediate supervision of the Chief Commissioner.

4. The Chief Commissioner is hereby designated as the Director of Civil Defense ex officio, and shall be responsible for the performance of all duties assigned to the Director of Civil Defense pursuant to Chapter 6, Title IX, Government Code of Guam.

5. The Director of Labor and Personnel will effect the transfer of all personnel concerned from the Department of Public Safety to the Office of the Chief Commissioner.

6. The Director of Finance will transfer the appropriation for the Department of Public Safety applicable

to the Office of Civil Defense for fiscal year 1964, including expenditures and obligations thereof prior to the date of this order, to the Office of the Chief Commissioner.

7. This Order shall take effect this date.
