
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 63- 28

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 61-22, as amended by Executive Order No. 61-25, established an Economic Development Commission with the function of studying problems of the economic development of Guam and advising the Governor thereon; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 7-45 established an Economic Incentive Commission with broad responsibility for developing and strengthening the economy, thus replacing the Economic Development Commission in this area.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the foregoing, Executive Order No. 61-22, as amended by Executive Order No. 61-25, is hereby repealed.
