EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 66-9

GOVERNOR'S ADVISORY
COMMITTEE FOR ANIMAL CONTROL


WHEREAS, the problem of animals at large is one of major concern in Guam; and

WHEREAS, animals must receive humane treatment in quarantine or when held as estrays, under Title XIII of the Government Code of Guam; and


WHEREAS, there is a need to establish a Committee to review regulations and laws, to establish effective methods of animal control and treatment, and to advise the Governor and Departments of Public Safety, Public Health and Welfare and Agriculture in all matters pertaining to animal control, including public education;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Manuel F. L. Guerrero, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam do hereby establish the "Governor's Advisory Committee on Animal Control" to be composed of seven (7) members to be selected by and to serve at the pleasure of the Governor commencing upon appointment and for such term as is necessary for the public welfare.
