## DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, SECURITY DIVISION

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has general cognizance over law enforcement in the territory of Guam; and

WHEREAS, as part of this responsibility the Department is charged with the protection and security of all government property and facilities; and

WHEREAS, it would be desirable for this function to be performed by a separate division within the Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Sections 6(b) and 9(c) of the Organic Act of Guam, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. There is hereby established within the Department of Public Safety a Division which shall be known as the Security Division.

2. The Security Division shall be responsible for the protection and security of all government property and facilities.

3. Section 3 of Executive Order 65-4 and all other Executive Orders heretofore issued in conflict herewith are repealed.

4. This Order shall take effect this date.
