
AMENDMENT OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 63-4 --
GOVERNOR'S COMMITTEE ON PROBLEMS OF THE AGING

WHEREAS, Executive Order 63-4 established the Governor's Committee on Problems of the Aging, composed of five members, for the purpose of studying the problems of our senior citizens as well as to consider their place and function in our society; and


WHEREAS, it would be in the public interest to enlarge the composition of the Committee so as to give greater representation of all segments of our society;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kurt S. Moylan, Acting Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam do hereby amend Executive Order 63-4 so that the Governor's Committee on Problems of the Aging shall be composed of fifteen members to be appointed by the Governor, one of which shall be designated chairman. Five members shall be appointed for one-year terms, five members shall be appointed for two-year terms, and five members shall be appointed for three-year terms.
