EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 69-9

RECOGNITION OF UNION - REFUSE COLLECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, Chapter 7 of Title V, Government Code of Guam, authorizes the Governor to recognize any bona fide labor organization whose membership is composed in whole or in part of government employees as the representative of such employees; and

WHEREAS, Operating Engineers Local Union No. 3 of the International Union of Operating Engineers, AFL-CIO, has demonstrated that it represents a majority of the Refuse Collectors in the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, Operating Engineers Local Union No. 3 has requested that it be designated as the sole and exclusive bargaining agent for employees of the Department of Public Works assigned as Refuse Collector;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Chapter 7 of Title V, Government Code of Guam, it is hereby ordered:

- 1. Operating Engineers Local Union No. 3 is hereby recognized as the sole and exclusive bargaining agent for employees of the Department of Public Works assigned as Refuse Collector.
- 2. The Director of Administration shall implement the provisions of Chapter 7 of Title V, Government Code of Guam, so as to provide for deduction of employees¹ union dues in furtherance of this Executive Order.
