TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

WHEREAS, BERNICE ANN HARA TORRES BORJA (née BERNICE ANN HARA TORRES), who petitioned for pardon was convicted in 1994 by the Superior Court of Guam in Case No. CF109-94 of three counts of possession of a firearm without an identification card and was sentenced to serve 3 years incarceration, suspended in lieu of probation and community service; and

WHEREAS, in 1997, Ms. Borja successfully completed her probation and community service sentences; and

WHEREAS, in the 20 years since her conviction, Ms. Borja has been actively employed, has raised a family, and has obtained several higher education degrees, including an Associate, Bachelor, and Masters degree; and

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2014, the Guam Pardon Review Board, after careful investigation, review and examination of the facts with respect to Ms. Borja in this matter has favorably recommended that the Governor pardon her; and

WHEREAS, it would best serve the ends of justice and is in the interests of Guam to unconditionally pardon Ms. Borja; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDDIE BAZA CALVO, I Maga'Låhen Guåhan, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act and laws of Guam, do unconditionally pardon BERNICE ANN HARA TORRES BORJA (BERNICE ANN HARA TORRES) of the offenses convicted, charged, and contained in Superior Court Case No. CF109-94, and grant her all rights, privileges, and immunities which by law attach and result from the operation of these presents.
