TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

WHEREAS, MICHAEL JOSEPH GOMBAR, who petitioned for pardon was convicted in 2001 by the Superior Court of Guam in Case No. CF025-01 of Vehicle Negligence with Injuries and was sentenced to serve 6 months incarceration, suspended in lieu of probation, community service, and restitution; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gombar successfully completed his probation and community service sentences and fully paid the restitution; and

WHEREAS, in the over 15 years since his conviction, Mr. Gombar has been actively employed, has obtained a Bachelors degree, is working on a Masters degree, and serves as a volunteer for numerous charitable and community service programs; and

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2016, the Guam Pardon Review Board, after careful investigation, review and examination of the facts with respect to Mr. Gombar in this matter has favorably recommended that the Governor pardon him; and

WHEREAS, it would best serve the ends of justice and is in the interests of Guam to unconditionally pardon Mr. Gombar; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDDIE BAZA CALVO, I Maga'Låhen Guåhan, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act and laws of Guam, do unconditionally pardon MICHAEL JOSEPH GOMBAR of the offenses convicted, charged, and contained in Superior Court Case No. CF025-01, and grant him all rights, privileges, and immunities which by law attach and result from the operation of these presents.
