

Like projects to construct the Guam and Chamorro Educational Facility and to renovate Skinner Plaza, the Inarajan Community Center work is funded through the Hotel Occupancy Tax (HOT) Bond. RIM Architects is the design firm and dck Pacific is the contractor. It utilizes proceeds from the HOT Bond to fund various projects, including the renovation and restoration of Plaza de España and the construction of the GCEF in Hagåtña. The total cost of these projects is estimated at \$70 million.

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
