



- d. A representative from the Department of Public Health & Social Services (DPHSS) Division of Senior Citizens;
 - e. A representative from the Department of Education;
 - f. The Chairman of the Guam Chamber of Commerce shall be invited to appoint a representative from the Chamber of Commerce;
 - g. The Chairman of the Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association shall be invited to appoint a representative from the GHRA; and
 - h. A chairperson, who shall be appointed at the discretion of the Governor.
3. The Planning Team shall design, develop and implement a pilot program for integrated mass transit that runs 24-hours-a-day, 7-days a week. The pilot program shall incorporate public bus stops operated by the Department of Public Works and shall be designed to run along high-density transit corridors and routes generally utilized by tour bus companies within the villages of Tamuning, Tumon, the Harmon, and Dededo.
4. Upon development of a pilot program, the Task Force shall conduct a public hearing to solicit comments and testimony. Thereafter, GEDA shall develop and issue a Request for Proposals for the implementation and operation of the pilot program developed and recommended by the Planning Team.
