RE: Freedom of Information Act Request - Information on Lobbying, and Communication with Department of Defense Relative to Medical Complex

Hafa Adai Speaker Terlaje:

We are in receipt of your Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") request dated October 25, 2023, received by the Office of the Governor, relative to the following:

[A]ll plans and communication records, including emails, letters, memoranda, and any other relevant documents, pertaining to the proposed veterans "clinic," veterans "hospital," "veterans administration facility", and "VA Facility" referred to by Matrix in its Medical Campus Master Plan.

[A]ll documents and correspondence related to the statement in the Pacific Daily News (PDN) article on October 24, 2023.

[A]ny relevant documentation or communication related to negotiations with or offers made by the Department of Defense to build a hospital for the people of Guam or to provide financial support for a hospital or medical facility to be managed by the government of Guam.
